June 29, 2022 6:15 PM

I. CALL TO ORDER

Mayor Mclsaac called the meeting to order at 6:15 PM in the Baltic City Hall.

II. ROLL CALL

Answering roll call were Councilpersons Schreurs, Oien and Sinding. Councilman Tidemann was present via phone. City Attorney John Hughes was present via Teams. Also present was Finance Officer Linda Hunnel.

III. PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

Mayor Mclsaac led the audience in the Pledge of Allegiance.

IV. NEW BUSINESS

a. Fireworks Permit

Request from Cody Reese and neighbors to have Aana Ave closed on Monday July 4th from 4PM-11PM for festivities. Clean up will follow. Closure request would go from the intersection of 6th and Aana west to 525 Aana Ave. Schreurs motioned to approve. Sinding seconded. All ayes. Motion passes for temporary street closure.

b. Allowance of Fireworks within City Limits.

Currently Regulation 130.05 states the setting off of fireworks is allowed on July 4th from 8:00 a.m. to 11:00 p.m. Citizens have expressed interest in having the ordinance extended to include the 3rd due to how the holiday falls on the calendar. Discussion shifted to a possible ban due to dry weather conditions. Councilman Sinding had been approached with concerns of fire danger. Fire Chief Koopman was in attendance. At this time we aren't in the mandates of a ban. Chief Koopman and other citizens encouraged celebrations to have safety measures, such as an extinguisher or garden hose, in place. Possibility of having a city celebration with safety precautions available was brought up. Schreurs motioned to allow fireworks to be set off in city limits on July 3rd & 4th from 8AM – 11PM. Motion was seconded by Sinding. All ayes. Motion passes.

Mayor Mclsaac made a request of the community. There are a considerable number of citizens from the North and South side of town that set off an impressive display. A call to action will be sent out next spring to see if we can make July 4th a community event. Mayor Mclsaac asked that everyone watch for details to be released.

As the fireworks discussion came to a close, Chief Koopman asked that everyone setting of fireworks use caution and make sure to dispose of them properly.

Maintenance Assistant position is still open. Please apply if interested.


V. ADJOURNMENT
