

Deborah McIsaac ("Plaintiff") and the City of Baltic and Linda Hunnel ("Defendants") having filed an unopposed motion for a scheduling order, the Court hereby ORDERS:

1. Notice of Appearance by any Intervenor must be filed by May 26, 2023.
2. Opening briefs by the Plaintiff, Defendants, and any Intervenor must be filed by June 2, 2023.
3. Response briefs by the Plaintiff, Defendants, and any Intervenor must be filed by June 9, 2023.
4. Hearing will be held before the Court on the 15th day of June, 2023, from 9:00 to 9:30 a.m. The hearing will be limited to oral argument related to the sufficiency of the grounds as stated in the Petition for Recall (Ex. A of the Complaint) and not on whether any conduct not specifically state in the Petition is "misconduct, malfeasance, nonfeasance, crimes in office, drunkenness, gross incompetency, corruption, theft, oppression, or gross partiality." Defendants' attorney may appear via telephone or video conference.
