Good morning, Lacey!

We at Mainly Marathons are hoping to return in May for a race if you will have us. We are hoping arrive in the afternoon on May 17 to prepare for the race on May 18. We would then have the race start at 0600 and go until approximately 1600. Attached are the COIs. We would also need three campsites if possible - in the past I have stopped by the office when I arrive in Baltic to pay for them and we have also given a check for a local organization as a thank you for letting us use your park.

A little about Mainly Marathons - we specialize in multiple days, multiple state races. We cover all 50 states each year. Baltic is part of our Prairie Series that starts in Miami...Oklahoma. Then each day we pack up and move to a new state. For this series we travel north from OK, MO, KS, NE, IA, SD, and then spend two days on the ND/MN border for a total of 8 races, 8 days, 8 states. We generally find ourselves in smaller communities (although not always) in hopes to make a positive financial impact on the area. Generally our races have 80-120 participants who are mostly out of state and a few from other countries. This means the participants will be utilizing local lodging, restaurants, gas stations, etc.
